Dear Parents:

Just a reminder, all families requesting financial assistance must complete the **FACTS Grant & Aid Application (\$25)**. Funds are limited, so families are encouraged to fill out an application as soon as possible.

Please note:

- No scholarship and/or assistance will be considered or renewed if the family has not completed the FACTS Grant & Aid Application.
- If you currently have any scholarships or assistance, you must re-apply for eligibility for the 17-18 School Year, even if your scholarship is "renewable."

To apply:

- **⇒** Log on to your FACTS account
- Select Grant & Aid Application
- Select 2017-2018 School Year
- Complete application in its entirety



The deadline for applications is *March 31, 2017*.
