Dear Parents:

Our Annual Christmas Program will be Thursday, December 21st. Students need to arrive at 6:30PM to meet their homeroom teachers and get ready. Students should arrive **NO LATER THAN 6:45PM**, and **NO EARLIER THAN 6:30PM**. Please drop off your students using the **MAIN DOORS**. Students will go to their assigned location, and parents will go to the Chapel.

In order to prepare for our Christmas Program, see below for what each grade will be wearing:

Preschool: Dress-up clothes, Christmas colors. No jeans.

Kindergarten: Black pants or skirts with Christmas colored shirts (green, red, yellow) or Christmas dresses

1st Grade: Black dress pants/skirts with white tops (dress shirts, blouses, or sweaters). Girls also have the option of wearing a black & white dress. (If you do not have black dress pants, please wear the navy school uniform pants).

2nd Grade: Red tops (sweater, blouse, or shirt) and dark bottoms (slacks or skirt).

3rd Grade: Sunday best with a Santa hat (please bring your own hat if you have one).

4th Grade: Black bottoms and a red or black shirt.

5th Grade: Red shirts and black pants. Girls may wear red dresses or black skirts if they choose.

6th Grade: School uniform pants and a white top.

7th Grade: Boys: Red tops, dark pants. Girls: White tops, dark pants.

8th Grade: Red and black.
