Christmas Program Thursday, December 21<sup>st</sup> 7:00PM, CHAPEL

Dear Parents:

Our Annual Christmas Program will be Thursday, December 21<sup>st</sup>. Students need to arrive at 6:30PM to meet their homeroom teachers and get ready. Students should arrive **NO LATER THAN** 6:45PM, and **NO EARLIER THAN** 6:30PM. Please drop off your students using the **MAIN DOORS**. Students will go to their assigned location, and parents will go to the Chapel.

In order to prepare for our Christmas Program, see below for what each grade will be wearing:

**Preschool:** Dress-up clothes, Christmas colors. No jeans.

<u>Kindergarten</u>: Black pants or skirts with Christmas colored shirts (green, red, yellow) or Christmas dresses

<u>**1**</u><sup>st</sup> **Grade:** Black dress pants/skirts with white tops (dress shirts, blouses, or sweaters). Girls also have the option of wearing a black & white dress. (If you do not have black dress pants, please wear the navy school uniform pants).

<u>2<sup>nd</sup> Grade:</u> Red tops (sweater, blouse, or shirt) and dark bottoms (slacks or skirt).

<u>**3**</u><sup>rd</sup> **Grade:** Sunday best with a Santa hat (please bring your own hat if you have one).

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade:** Black bottoms and a red or black shirt.

<u>5<sup>th</sup> Grade</u>: Red shirts and black pants. Girls may wear red dresses or black skirts if they choose.

**<u>6</u><sup>th</sup> Grade:** School uniform pants and a white top.

7<sup>th</sup> Grade: Boys: Red tops, dark pants. Girls: White tops, dark pants.

**8<sup>th</sup> Grade:** Red and black.
