For those of you who still need to sign your tuition agreement for the 2018-2019 school year, you may stop at the school office anytime during normal business hours.

The school office is open from 7:30 a.m. – 3:30 each school day.

Tuition agreements will not be sent home. Tuition agreements must be signed and registration fee paid before March 1st to lock in the current 2017-2018 tuition rate. All tuition rates will increase on March 1st for the 2018-2019 school year.
