As we head into the final weeks of school we would like to remind everyone that **all account balances including tuition**, **extended care and lunch** need to be up to date and paid in full for your child(ren) to participate in any year end activities including but not limited to field trips, end of year parties, ceremonies and graduation. Report cards and diplomas will be held until all balances are paid in full for the 2017-2018 school year.

8th grade parents please note that some of you have a last payment date for the school year due on May 30th and May 31st. All tuition and account balance for the 2017/2018 school year must be paid in full by May 25th. The 8th grade field trip is on May 29th and kicks off the 8th grade festivities and graduation is on June 2^{nd.} For your child to participate in the 8th grade field trip and all other 8th grade activities and in order to receive their 8th grade diploma, all balances must be paid in full before May 25th. For those of you have an automatic withdrawal for tuition, we can change your payment date to reflect that May 25th date, with a phone call from you.
