<u>Health Exam Updates</u>: Letters went home to students in grades Pk4, 1, and 5 about updates needed on the health records. Students entering Kindergarten need updated physicals, dental and vision exams; students entering 2nd grade need updated dental exams, and students entering 6th grade need updated physical and dental exams. Please refer to the packets your child will bring home for more information.

Reminder:

As we head into the final two weeks of school we would like to remind everyone that **all account balances including tuition**, **extended care and lunch** need to be up to date and paid in full by **May 31**st for your child(ren) to participate in any year-end activities. This includes, but is not limited to, field trips, the all school field day on June 6th, end of year parties, Honor Roll Ceremonies and year-end graduation assembly for Preschool and Kindergarten.

Report cards and diplomas will be held until all balances are paid in full for the 2017-2018 school year.

Empower Illinois Scholarship Update

- You may have noticed the tuition amount in your FACTS account is not the same as your signed agreement for the 2018/2019 school year, do not be concerned.
- Empower awards the scholarships per student not per family, so your FACTS agreement had to be adjusted to show the base tuition rate per child.
- If you do not receive a scholarship through Empower by July 1st we will adjust your tuition back to the rates that are on your signed agreement.
- Once the scholarships are added to your FACTS accounts you will receive another notification showing that a change has been made.
