IMPORTANT REMINDER:

All payments for tuition, lunch, and before/after care for the 2017—2018 school year were due today. **No students will be allowed to participate in any end of year activities unless the balance on all accounts has been paid in full.** Activities include the Field Day scheduled for June 6th, end of year parties, Honor Roll Ceremonies and year-end graduation assemblies for Preschool and Kindergarten.

Report cards and diplomas will be held until all balances are paid in full for the 2017-2018 school year.

Health Exam Updates: Don't forget: Students entering grades K, 2, and 6 will need updated health records in August. Students entering Kindergarten need updated physicals, dental and vision exams; students entering 2nd grade need updated dental exams, and students entering 6th grade need updated physical and dental exams. Empower Illinois Scholarship Update

- ◆ You may have noticed the tuition amount in your FACTS account is not the same as your signed agreement for the 2018/2019 school year, do not be concerned.
- ◆ Empower awards the scholarships per student not per family, so your FACTS agreement had to be adjusted to show the base tuition rate per child.
- ◆ If you do not receive a scholarship through Empower by July 1st we will adjust your tuition back to the rates that are on your signed agreement.
- ◆ Once the scholarships are added to your FACTS accounts you will receive another notification showing that a change has been made.
