UNIFORM CODE REMINDER

BOYS: Grades K-8*

White long or short sleeve dress shirt (Must be purchased through School Belles)

Navy twill trousers and belt (Must be purchased through School Belles)

Navy sweater or vest with St. Ferdinand logo (Must be purchased through School Belles)

Navy striped tie (Must be purchased through School Belles, grades 5-8)

Black closed-toe dress shoes

* Boys grades 5-8 must wear a belt, optional for lower grades

GIRLS: Grades K-4

White or light blue blouse (Must be purchased through School Belles)

Pleated jumper or drop-waist jumper (Must be purchased through School Belles)

Navy sweater or vest with St. Ferdinand logo (Must be purchased through School Belles)

Black closed-toe dress shoes

GIRLS: Grades 5-8

White or light blue blouse (Must be purchased through School Belles)

Navy twill trousers and belt (Must be purchased through School Belles)

Navy Sweater or vest with St. Ferdinand logo (Must be purchased through School Belles)

Black closed-toe dress shoes

Just a reminder: The uniform shoe for all students is a black, closed-toe dress shoes. Students should *NOT* wear gym shoes with their regular uniforms. Gym shoes can *ONLY* be worn on gym days.

All students may wear navy dress walking shorts from the first day of school through September 30, and from May 1 to the end of the school year. Sweaters are not required during these dates.
