Health records are due! Please turn these in as soon as possible to avoid exclusion.

Students entering *Kindergarten* needed updated eye, dental, and health exams.

Students entering *2nd grade* needed updated dental exams.

Students entering *6th grade* needed updated health exams/immunizations, as well as an updated dental exam.

Health Records: If you have not yet turned in your required physical/immunization records to the office (Grades K, 6, and all new students), letters were sent home last week. <u>Records must be received by October 1 in order to avoid exclusion.</u> Please contact the office with any questions. <u>This is especially important for 6th grade parents, as very few have turned in their physicals.</u>

☑ <u>Uniform Reminder:</u> Please remember to wear the correct uniform to school! Pants, blouses, sweaters, and ties must be the ones purchased through SchoolBelles. *Jeggings or other tight-fitting pants are NOT allowed*. Shoes must also be <u>closed-toe dress</u> <u>shoes: Gym shoes are ONLY allowed on gym days! (except Preschool)</u>. Out of uniform notices will be given out: A detention will be issued after 3 infractions. <u>Please also remember that hair should NOT be dyed! Please refer to pages 34-35 of the Family/</u><u>Student Handbook for further clarification</u>.
