2019-2020 TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS OPEN



We are excited to announce that applications for 2019-2020 tax credit scholarships will open on **Tuesday, January 15, 2019 at 7 p.m. CT**. The application will again be a two-step process. **Part one** will open on **January 15** and will timestamp applications. While timestamps do matter, a student's place in line does not guarantee an award. All scholarships are subject to the availability of funds at the school of choice. Schools and families will be notified when **part two** of the application is available. Families can complete part two on their family portal and are encouraged to submit their application as soon as possible.

☑ **Arrival/Dismissal Safety:** Lately, there have been several safety concerns involving traffic at drop-off and arrival. Parents, **please** remember not to block traffic! Once students exit the car, the driver should continue to drive away. If you are dropping off on Mason Ave., please do **NOT** get out of your car to walk your child to the door, as this slows down the line and causes problems. **If you need to walk your student to the door, you must PARK your car in the PARKING LOT and walk with your child to the entrance door.** Additionally: Please avoid the excess honking, yelling, and road rage! It is not fair to our students that they should start their day by hearing yelling and noise. There are many students to be dropped off—so if we work together, we can make the process work smoothly. We need to have both consideration for cars behind us, as well as patience for cars ahead of us.

Dear Parents:

Our Annual Christmas Program will be Thursday, December 20th. Students need to arrive at **6:30PM** to meet their homeroom teachers and get ready. Students should arrive **NO LATER THAN 6:45PM**, and **NO EARLIER THAN 6:30PM**. Please drop off your students using the **MAIN DOORS**. Students will go to their assigned location, and parents will go to the Chapel.

Please remember—this is a concert, so students need to wear **dress clothes**. Jeans and jeggings are NOT allowed.

In order to prepare for our Christmas Program, see below for what each grade will be wearing:

Preschool: Dress-up clothes, Christmas colors. No jeans.

Kindergarten: Black pants or skirts with Christmas colored shirts, or Christmas colored dresses

1st Grade: Black dress pants/skirts with white tops (dress shirts, blouses, or sweaters). Girls also have the option of wearing a black & white dress.

2nd Grade: Dress-up clothes, Christmas colors. No jeans.

3rd Grade: Black pants (or skirt) with either a Silver, White, or Black shirt/blouse.

4th Grade: Black bottoms and a red or white shirt.

5th Grade: Navy, white, or gold top with black bottoms.

6th Grade: "Gold" group: Black pants and either a white or gold (yellow) shirt
"Frankincense" group: Black pants, red shirt
"Myrrh" group: Black pants and either dark blue or black shirt

7th Grade: Dress-up clothes, Christmas colors. No jeans, no jeggings.

8th Grade: White shirts, black pants
