iReady / Headphones

This year, students in grades K-8 will be using iReady software. Because of this, each student is asked to bring to school their own pair of earbuds. iReady is a computer-based diagnostic tool that assesses individual student learning and generates instructional activities specifically designed for each student in Math and Reading.
