# Cell Phones/ Apple Watches/ Smart Watches / Cell Phones

Just a reminder—students are not to have/use cell phones during the school day. This includes recess time as well. Smart watches (devices similar to Apple watches), or similar electronic devices that can be used for communication or internet, are likewise not allowed. Electronic devices will be taken away, and parents will need to pick them up from the office.

#### **Reminders**

Headphones/Earbuds: Because students are using iReady software, each student in grades K-8 is asked to have their own pair of earbuds / headphones with them to use with the program. More information on iReady is on the back of this newsletter.

☑ <u>Walking Home Permission</u>: Parents that wish to have their children walk home may fill out a permission slip. Permission slips went home with students in grades 6-8. Parents of students in other grades should contact the office for a form.

☑ <u>Health Records</u>: Students in grades K, 2, and 6 were required to turn in updated health records at the beginning of the school year. If you have not yet turned these in, please do so now. Letters went home today indicating if we are missing any required physical, dental, or vision exams for your student. Since the requirements are set by the State of Illinois, students that do not have their updated physicals/immunization records on file with the office do run the risk of exclusion in October.

☑ <u>Arrival / Dismissal Times</u>: Please note, school doors open at 7:40AM. Students should arrive between 7:40−7:55AM. Any student arriving after 7:55AM will have to check in at the office, and will be marked as tardy. Dismissal is from 2:45PM−2:55PM in the parking lot. Students not picked up by 3:00PM will be charged for after school care.

☑ **Sports Council Needed:** We still need parents for sports council! Please see enclosed letter.

☑ <u>Uniforms</u>: Just a reminder, students should be in the proper uniform. Skinny pants/jeggings are not acceptable as uniform pants. Socks should be solid colored, and shoes should be solid black, grey, navy or white.
