Christmas Program Thursday, December 19th 7:00PM, CHAPEL

Our Annual Christmas Program will be Thursday, December 19th. Students need to arrive at 6:30PM to meet their homeroom teachers and get ready. Students should arrive **NO LATER THAN** 6:45PM, and **NO EARLIER THAN** 6:30PM. Please drop off your students using the **MAIN DOORS**. Students will go to their assigned location, and parents will go to the Chapel.

Please remember—this is a concert, so students need to wear **dress clothes**. <u>Jeans and jeggings are</u> **NOT allowed.** Gym shoes are not allowed.

In order to prepare for our Christmas Program, see below for what each grade will be wearing:

Preschool: Dress-up clothes, Christmas colors. No jeans, no gym shoes.

Kindergarten: Dress-up clothes, Christmas colors. No jeans, no gym shoes.

1st Grade: Dress-up clothes, Christmas colors. No jeans, no gym shoes.

2nd Grade: Dress-up clothes, Christmas colors. No jeans, no gym shoes.

Students in the following grade levels should wear something with the color assigned (for girls it could be a dress, skirt, shirt, sweater, etc.; for boys it can be shirt, sweater, vest, pants, etc.). If anyone has any issue with their assigned color they can resort to wearing the colors white and black or white and navy blue, and if possible to please make every effort to add an embellishment with that color (for girls that can be any jewelry, hair accessories, or a scarf; for boys it could be a scarf, tie, bow tie, etc.) NO JEANS ALLOWED!

3rd Grade: Red

4th Grade: Blue

5th Grade: Red

6th Grade: Blue

7th **Grade:** White and Black with Silver or Gold embellishments (could be jewelry, hair accessories, scarf, tie, bow tie, etc.)

8th Grade: Black T shirts and Black pants (Note: 8th Grade is an exception since they will be performing a song that requires movement)
