After we receive your intent to return form, we will send you your tuition agreement.

**February Freeze Discount** Registration for the 21/22 School Year is now officially **open!** Once again, we are able to offer our **February Freeze** discount (tuition for the 2021-22 school year is charged at the published 2020-21 rates) for families that re-enroll for the 2021/22 School Year by the last day of school in February – Friday, February 26. #### Attention all St. Ferdinand School Families: Changes to FACTS Payment Methods

Beginning with the 2020/2021 school year, all Families must have either a checking/savings account or credit card linked to their FACTS account. All families that currently have an invoice account will need to sign into their FACTS account to add your preferred payment method. *This is not optional.*

Donate to a Tax Credit Scholarship Give the gift of Catholic education. Triple your impact of a tax credit scholarship with the 2-for-1 matching gift program. To help donations have even more impact in 2021/22, several donors have agreed to pool their resources and offer a 2-for-1 matching gift program to the more than 160 schools run by the Archdiocese of Chicago. The matching pool fund is at \$2.8 million with funds still being actively raised. This means for every dollar designated to a qualifying school through the Empower Illinois scholarship granting organization between Dec. 1, 2020 and Feb. 28, 2021, the school will receive two dollars in matching funds. <u>GRADES/HONOR ROLL</u> - Please note, the grade scale for Specials Classes (Physical Education, Fine Arts, Spanish, Technology) has changed. These classes are now using the +, S, and – grade scale.

- + (outstanding work)
- S (satisfactory work)
- (unsatisfactory work)

For the A/High Honor Roll, Grades 4-8 students need to have all A's in the subject areas still being graded, and +'s in the Specials.

For the B Honor Roll, Grades 4-8 students need to earn a combo of A's and B's (no C's or lower), and have all +'s and S's (no -'s) in the Specials.

<u>Gym Uniforms</u> - Please make sure you have the correct gym uniform! Last year was the final transition year for uniforms. This year, all gym uniforms should be the navy blue ones, as offered through <u>Dennis Uniform</u>. *If you do not have the correct uniform, this will start to be reflected in your grade.* 

<u>Sweaters/Uniforms</u> - As the weather is getting colder, please remember to dress appropriately ... students should now be in pants, NOT walking shorts. Make sure to bring your St. Ferdinand School fleece sweater jacket (the Dennis Uniform one) to wear during the school day. Due to COVID, we do need to keep the windows open to provide more ventilation – and as the temperature drops outside, so does the temperature in the classroom.
