

St. Ferdinand School EASTER EXTRAVAGANZA Split-the-Pot Raffle





Dear Parents:

Because there is no Fish Fry this year, we will hold a special Easter Extravaganza Splitthe-Pot Raffle! The 1<sup>st</sup> Prize winner will receive 50% of  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the total collected; 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize will receive 30% of  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the total collected, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize will receive 20% of  $\frac{1}{2}$  the total collected. **The more \$ we collect, the more \$ you win!** 

Every family is receiving an envelope with 10 tickets. Each ticket is worth \$5. If you wish to participate in the raffle, please return the ticket stub (we kindly ask that you cut off the top portion that has your contact info and return that part to the school) and payment to the school office by **Tuesday**, **March 30**. Since these tickets have not been paid for, payment must accompany your ticket stubs in order to be in the raffle drawing. The drawing will be held on Wednesday, March 31.

How does a split-the-pot raffle work? Let's say each family (approx.. 100) sells an average of 4 tickets for \$20. 100 x \$20 = \$2,000 brought in. Of that money brought in, \$1,000 straight profit to SFS / \$1,000 divided among winners: 1st place - 50% of  $\frac{1}{2}$  the pot = \$500 2nd place - 30% of  $\frac{1}{2}$  the pot = \$300 3rd place - 20% of  $\frac{1}{2}$  the pot = \$200

As you can see, the more money brought in, the greater the amount! **And tickets are only \$5 each – you may get as many as you'd like!** All proceeds will be used to benefit St. Ferdinand School.
