<u>Parking Lot and Dismissal Reminders</u>
Lately, there has been some concern about safety in the parking lot at dismissal time. Parents – please remember that masks are **required**

while picking up your children, per city ordinance and school safety protocol. Failure to do so poses a health risk, and you will be asked to leave the property if you do not have a mask.

Also, there has been some expressed concern regarding our younger students climbing on the guardrails and fence, as well as general roughhousing, in the parking lot after school. To ensure the safety of our students at dismissal time, we ask that we please work together to curb this behavior. Although we realize students have had to sit in their desks for a greater part of the day and are eager and ready to stretch and be with friends for a few minutes before heading home, it has to be done in a safe manner. Wild running, chasing, pushing, and climbing will not be tolerated.
