invoice account will need to sign into their FACTS account to add your preferred payment method. *This is not optional.*

<u>GRADES/HONOR ROLL</u> - Please note, the grade scale for Specials Classes (Physical Education, Fine Arts, Spanish, Technology) has changed. These classes are now using the +, S, and – grade scale.

For the A/High Honor Roll, Grades 4-8 students need to have all A's in the subject areas still being graded, and +'s in the Specials.
