**Progress Reports** - We are halfway through the 2<sup>nd</sup> Trimester! Progress reports went home today for Grades 1-8. Please sign and return the reports for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students; please access PowerSchool and then sign and return the reports for students in grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>. All Progress Reports should be returned by THIS Monday, January 24.

**Volleyball is Starting!** - Today, girls in Grades 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> that were interested received the signup packet to join our Volleyball Teams! **Library Card Applications** – If you are interested in your child receiving a Chicago Public Library Card, or replacing an old one, please see the applications that went home last week are included in the links section. Cards will be delivered to the school.

<u>**Illness / Covid Protocol Reminders**</u> – Just a reminder, if your student is feeling sick, please do not send them to school. Please contact the office to let us know why your student will not be in school.

## We ask that parents/guardians continue to monitor your child for the following COVID symptoms:

- Fever
- Congestion/cough/sore throat new symptoms with Omnicron variant
- Runny nose
- Loss of taste or smell symptom of Delta variant
- Lethargy/extreme sluggishness

## If someone tests positive for COVID, regardless of vaccination status, the individual must:

- Isolate for a full 5 days regardless if symptoms are present or not and regardless if any symptoms resolve before the 5 days are complete.
- If asymptomatic or symptoms resolve before the fifth day, the individual must still complete the full five days of isolation and must wear a mask around others for five more days.
- The individual must be fever-free for 24 hours before leaving isolation. The 5-day rule still applies, but if a fever is present after 5 days, the individual must remain isolated until fever-free for 24 hours.

#### If a vaccinated individual is a close contact with a positive individual:

- There is no need to quarantine at home as long as the individual is not symptomatic. The individual must wear a mask around others for 10 days after exposure.
- Testing is recommended 5 days after exposure OR if symptoms develop.

#### If an *unvaccinated* individual is a close contact with a positive individual:

- The individual must quarantine at home for 5 days and continue to wear a mask around others for 5 more days.
- Testing is recommended 5 days after exposure OR if symptoms develop

<u>Say No to Throwing Snow</u> – Even though the snow looks fun to play with, we ask that students do not play in or throw snow while on school grounds. We ask this for the safety of everyone. It is no fun to get hit by an unexpected snowball, and we certainly don't want anyone getting hurt on rocks that might be in the piles of plowed snow. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping everyone safe.
