**St. Ferdinand in the News** – What an amazing buzz our Cuddle Buddies Community Outreach Project has become in the media! On February 7, St. Ferdinand School was showcased live on Chicago Catholic Radio discussing their Community Social Outreach Project: Caring Across the Council. This project involved selling Cuddle Buddy bracelets to raise money with which to help 2 families from nearby St. Bartholomew School that lost their shared home to a fire. Principal Folino, Kindergarten teacher Mrs Rettelle, and Student Council Officers Cecylia, Deren, and Zofia discussed both the project and what they learned through their work on the project. Between proceeds from the sale and generous donations from students and families, over \$1,000 of money and items was raised for the families. On Monday, February 14, these items were delivered to St. Bartholomew School and presented to the families at an assembly. Various news stations (TV: ABC, WGN, and Fox; Radio: WBBM – AM and FM) were there to capture the event and interview students – and the story was picked up by news affiliates in three other states - - - AND there still might be more media coverage to come! We are grateful that we were able to help these families, as well as spread some good news and hope to the community! **Fish Fry – Volunteers Needed!** – Fish Fry begins March 4. A volunteer sign-up sheet was sent home today. This is a great opportunity for parents to sign up to do their required volunteer hours! As a reminder, 10 parent service hours are required for every family, or a \$250 charge will appear on the April tuition statement.

**<u>SAFETY AT DISMISSAL TIME:</u>** It has come to our attention from our crossing guard that dangerous situations are taking place at dismissal time. To ensure the safety of our children, parents, teachers, the St. Patrick High School community, and our crossing guard, please:

- Do NOT double-park along Mason.

- Do NOT park in the alley off of Mason; the neighbors are complaining about obstruction down the one-way alley

- If parked on Mason, only travel on it heading south to leave the school premises - do NOT back up onto Belmont to exit

- Get out of your car to pick up your child and walk him/her to your vehicle after acknowledging your presence to your child's teacher

- Consider using our ample parking lot and exiting out Marmora - there is plenty of room and space for all, with no street for your child to cross

Thank you for your immediate cooperation with this, and thank you to those who already do park in safe ways at pick-up.

### PARENTS/GUARDIANS! PLEASE WEAR YOUR MASKS WHEN PICKING UP YOUR CHILDREN

**FROM SCHOOL!** Teachers and staff are so diligent during the school day in efforts to follow protocol and to keep your children (and themselves!) SAFE and HEALTHY while in our building and on our grounds. There have been a couple of incidents in which parents/guardians are approaching our teachers/staff at pick-up unmasked. **PLEASE WEAR A MASK AT PICK-UP UNTIL YOU ARE BACK IN YOUR CAR.** Thank you for your cooperation with keeping everyone safe.

**It's Tax Season! End of Year Tuition Info for Taxes** – A flier went out with instructions on how to obtain year end tuition information for tax prep purposes. Please use these for tax purposes.

<u>Financial Aid/Scholarships</u> - The 2022/2023 FACTS Grant & Aid application is now open. If you receive any type of financial aid/scholarship through the Archdiocese, (Phoenix, COVID Relief or Access), McGraw Foundation, or St. Ferdinand School, you are required to fill out a Grant & Aid Application for the 2022/2023 school year. Please note: <u>Per scholarship rules, no</u> <u>financial aid/scholarships will be considered without this application.</u>

<u>Say No to Throwing Snow</u> – Even though the snow looks fun to play with, we ask that students do not play in or throw snow while on school grounds. We ask this for the safety of everyone. It is no fun to get hit by an unexpected snowball, and we certainly don't want anyone getting hurt on rocks that might be in the piles of plowed snow. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping everyone safe.

<u>Illness / Covid Protocol Reminders</u> – Just a reminder, if your student is feeling sick, please do not send them to school. Please contact the office to let us know why your student will not be in school.

### We ask that parents/guardians continue to monitor your child for the following COVID symptoms:

- Fever
- Congestion/cough/sore throat new symptoms with Omicron variant
- Runny nose
- Loss of taste or smell symptom of Delta variant
- Lethargy/extreme sluggishness

## If someone tests positive for COVID, regardless of vaccination status, the individual must:

- Isolate for a full 5 days regardless if symptoms are present or not and regardless if any symptoms resolve before the 5 days are complete.
- If asymptomatic or symptoms resolve before the fifth day, the individual must still complete the full five days of isolation and must wear a mask around others for five more days.
- The individual must be fever-free for 24 hours before leaving isolation. The 5-day rule still applies, but if a fever is present after 5 days, the individual must remain isolated until fever-free for 24 hours.

### If a *vaccinated* individual is a close contact with a positive individual:

- There is no need to quarantine at home as long as the individual is not symptomatic. The individual must wear a mask around others for 10 days after exposure.
- Testing is recommended 5 days after exposure OR if symptoms develop.

#### If an *unvaccinated* individual is a close contact with a positive individual:

- The individual must quarantine at home for 5 days and continue to wear a mask around others for 5 more days.
- Testing is recommended 5 days after exposure OR if symptoms develop

All cars MUST pull over on either side of the street if you want to get out of your car and walk your child in! Do not leave your vehicle unattended in the middle of the street in the morning. Thank you for your cooperation with this.

**<u>iWatches/Smart Watches</u>** – are not allowed on the children during school hours! They need to be kept at home OR kept in backpacks in the lockers during the school day.
