Celebrate LATINO CULTURES!

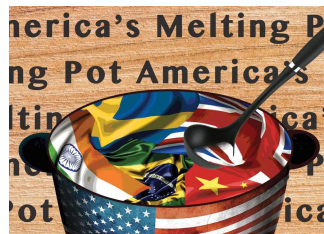
It's Cinco de Mayo! Celebrate by wearing the ethnic clothing or colors of Mexico, Puerto Rico, Columbia, Brazil, etc!
