FREE BREAKFAST is COMING TO FERD's! -

We are already blessed to have FREE LUNCH for all of our Ferd students, but now, starting on Monday, Nov 28, all students will be eligible to receive a FREE cold breakfast (cereal, granola bars, pop tarts, etc., plus a beverage)! Those in Morning Extended Care will automatically

receive their breakfast as part of the morning supervision and activities – but any student who would like a breakfast can enter the MAIN ENTRANCE between 7:15-7:45 AM daily to be directed to the breakfast-only room.

FUNDRAISERS 2022-23: Just a guick update on this. This year,

we are looking to meet designated school budget funding to be raised primarily from profits raised by 2 MAIN EVENTS: a Parent-Only Dinner/Fun Night Out/Auction in early February and a Color Run Fun Run for the students in the Spring! Other than that, we will not be promoting a lot of sales of "things" for profit like our former Christmas Candle or chocolate bar sales. received an envelope with forms (family index, emergency contact, walking permission, photo release, medical and emergency notification, school directory) to fill out and

return at the beginning of school. If you have not already returned these, please do so now. These forms are extremely important, so that we have your correct contact



information in the event we need to contact you. If you need additional forms, these are accessible online.

COVID Protocol Policy Remains the Same: Last winter, the

Archdiocese of Chicago released a letter stating that mask-wearing would be optional in its schools. This is in accordance with changes to Chicago and Illinois masking policies. However, because Covid is still prevalent, there will be times when masks may be necessary for the protection of all students in a

classroom, especially when social for an extended period of time and classroom. Therefore, we ask that backpacks at all times to be worn continuing to distance children at from water fountains but only from

We will receive and relay back to you the Archdiocese and CDC "official" 5-days quarantine dates + 5 days returning masked protocol based on onset of symptoms and positive test date. Notes of COVID cases in the school and within a homeroom will still be issued. Of course, we encourage all children and families to get vaccinated and boosted; it is, however, at this point optional to share vaccination/booster status with the School Office, where it is kept in confidential files. It is the hope of the St. Ferdinand Administration, Staff, and Faculty that we can continue to mitigate the spread of Covid and keep our school community healthy by adhering to these practices and having students/staff don masks when needed.
