St. Ferdinand School is hosting the quarterly Archdiocese of Chicago Office of Catholic Schools Leadership Day for principals and personnel in the Superintendent's Office on Wednesday, October 25. Here are some things that will be a little different that day around St. Ferdinand School:

DROP OFF - 7:45-8:00 AM

1st-3rd Graders will NOT use the JTC Entrance -Instead, 1st-3rd graders will use the MAIN SCHOOL ENTRANCE alongside Preschool and KG students.

> 4th-8th graders will still use the Polish School Entrance. Morning Care and Free Breakfast proceed as usual.

STUDENTS WILL NOT GO TO LUNCH; STUDENTS MAY BRING A SNACK TO HAVE AT A DESIGNATED SNACK TIME.

DISMISSAL - 12:20-12:35 ALONG MASON AVENUE

(like we did during Gym Roof Construction last fall)

Cars should pull up near the designated door OR park vehicles on Mason or along Barry and find your child at the designated times.

DO NOT DOUBLE PARK AS TO BLOCK TRAFFIC!

Note: families with more than one child will have both children dismissed along Mason Avenue WITH THE YOUNGEST CHILD'S CLASS

Children not picked up during the 5-Minute Window below will be escorted to Extended Care in the Activity Center.
