What should students wear? - The regular school uniform.

After school snack for students- Please send an afterschool snack for your child to eat in their homeroom before judging.

3:30pm - Students will go to the Activity Center and judging will begin.

How does the judging process work? - Students will present their project to two judges, separately, in front of their project boards. The judges will listen to the presentation, ask questions, and read through the written report. The judge will fill out a scoresheet to give to the science teacher and will also fill out a comment sheet to give to the student.

5:30pm - Students will be ready for pickup/dismissal at 5:30pm.

Judges get hungry, too!

Please consider sending some *snack items* to school in the morning with your child *for the judges to enjoy after school* while they are between judgments. Having some goodies, such as cheese, crackers, and cookies, available for judges is standard procedure at science fairs.
