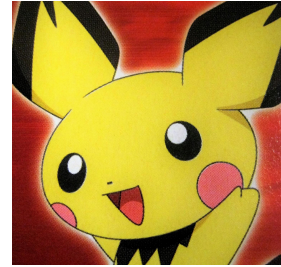

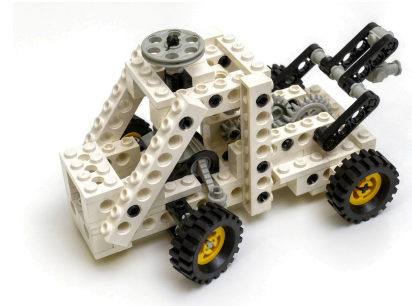

No art skills required, just curiosity and passion.

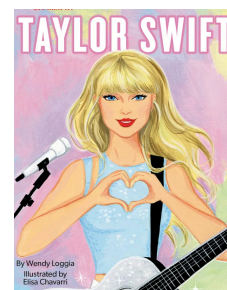
Taylor Swift Fan Club
