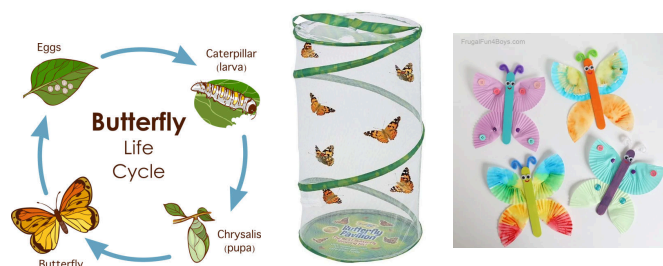
The Caterpillar Crew Club

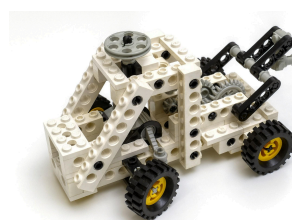
