Come ready to get a little messy and have a lot of fun—because learning can be ooey, gooey, and awesome! 


STEM Challenge Club:

The focus is on creativity, collaboration and critical thinking rather than right answers and no prior STEM experience is required just curiosity and a willingness to try (min of 6 students).


Pint-Sized Picassos
