Reel Creator Club

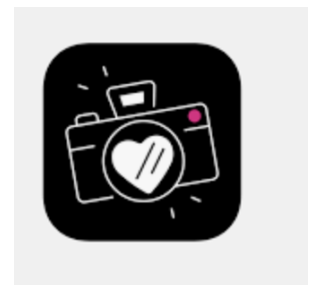

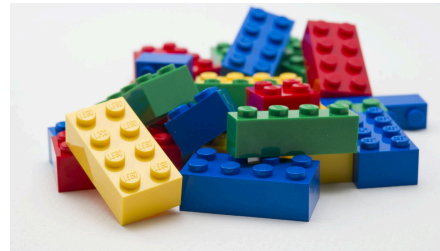
